Criterion: 100% are satisfied or very satisfied.

**Notes:** Work with Center Directors and the IAV Director to develop a simple questionnaire to be given to every faculty member teaching an IAV class fall 2015 and spring 2016.

**Criterion:** A list of courses available for students to take as dual credit will be established and available for students and parents. 90% of all Juniors will be given the Accuplacer test each Spring to prepare for enrollment in Fall courses. Eligible students will enroll in courses for the Fall semester following testing.
