IRE- Data - Conduct a satisfaction survey of college faculty and staff to ascertain whether or not they have the appropriate data they need to assess their own effectiveness. Evaluate IRE web pages and resources for ease of use and comprehensiveness. (Active)

Criterion: 90% of those surveyed are able to find what they need and use it effectively.

Notes: Add to and evaluate the data on the IRE web pages from 2014 through 2017 and then assess their comprehensiveness in 2017-18.

IRE- Data - Operational Outcomes Assessment Workshop 2014 evaluation results. (Active)

Criterion: 80% of workshop attendees will leave feeling better informed and supported in their assessment efforts. 80% of workshop attendees report improvement in knowledge of assessment and ability to assess their operations.

Notes: Depending on the workshop evaluation results, plan and present another workshop in the spring. Implement changes as indicated in the evaluations. Consider planning and implementing at least one assessment workshop per year until no longer needed.

IRE- Data - Conduct a qualitative review of completed operational assessment plans and reports as well as guidelines, worksheets, and templates for clear deadlines and expectations and comprehensive instructions. (Active)

Criterion: 100% of the guidelines, worksheets and templates are comprehensive, clearly communicated, with deadlines and expectations. 80% of the assessment plans and reports meet or exceed expectations.

Notes: Develop a rubric to assess the quality of assessment plans and reports. Collaborate with others to support the development of an institution-wide assessment plan that ties academic and operational assessment with performance evaluation, strategic planning, and GBC mission fulfillment.

Assessment Measures

IRE- Data - Review all NSHE and Legislative requests for data and information. Track due dates, submission dates, whether or not they were standard or ad hoc requests, the comparability and accuracy of the submissions. (Active)

Criterion: 100% of all submissions meet deadlines, are completely accurate, and are comparable to similar and/or previous requests.

Notes: Set-up a log sheet to track requests and submissions at the beginning of 2014-15. Track fields or data that we're not able to submit; track second submissions for data corrections; track due dates and submission dates. Consider tracking federal projects as well. Analyze data during summer 2015 and design interventions to ensure 100% data accuracy and timeliness. Track these projects as well.
