MEETING MINUTES – 6 October 2017, 10:00 am – 11:00 am

AGENDA:

- 1) Approval of 15 September 2017 Meeting Minutes—**APPROVED** via email conference 18-19 September 2017 [4 ayes, 2 non-responses; quorum met] – NOTE: Ex officio member (Library Director) accidentally added to vote total in minutes for 15 September 2017.

- 2) Proposal for a “GBC Library” link on main GBC website (see below) – **ACTION**
The Committee voted to approve the proposed language [6 ayes, 0 nays; quorum met]
The attached Action Item will be sent to Faculty Senate for approval – 20 October 2017

- 3) Review of Policies and Procedures for Library – **DISCUSSION POSTPONED**
The Library is still waiting on the final audit report from UNR, and would like to review the audit report before moving forward with a final Policies & Procedures draft. The Committee agrees with this request.

- 4) “Library Quiz” – Format and delivery
The Committee discussed the creation of an online Library Quiz. After discussing options for delivery, it was decided that creating a Creative Commons version which could be housed in WebCampus and which could be incorporated into INT-100, ENG, or other courses would be the best approach. Faculty would be invited to incorporate the final quiz into classes.

In terms of format, the Committee felt the Quiz should focus on two areas:

- a) Accessibility: Address issues such as how to contact the library, hours of operations, services offered, database access, holding information, etc.
- b) Skills: How to search for information, the differences in the various databases and collections, etc.

Since the Library is currently collecting and reviewing user feedback information, the Committee decided it would be useful to review this information to identify areas which the Library Quiz could help address. Discussion will continue in future meetings.

5) New Business

a) Community Building: Discussion grew out of the “Library Quiz” debate about how to increase traffic/community within the Library, which the Committee feels has been lacking. Three possibilities were discussed:

i) Creation of More “Group Areas” in Library: Feeling was this would attract students and others to library for study or club activities. It was agreed that some “quiet spaces” would need to be created simultaneously to balance the needs of the two groups.

ii) Vending Machines: Rather than have Library staff oversee the provision of coffee, the placement of vending machines in the hallway outside the back library entrance would help both traffic flow and make the library a more welcoming space (as well as address a deficiency on campus generally).

iii) Possible Integration of ASC Tutoring Services in the Library: While not feasible in the short term, the separation of the ASC and the Library makes GBC different from many other schools. It is not clear to the Committee how this decision was originally made.

These issues will continue to be discussed in future meetings.

b) External Signage: A proposal was made to consider increased external signage for the Library as a means of guiding persons on campus to the Library. One possibility discussed was something similar to the “flag” device currently used by VRC to advertise coffee. Two of these devices, located at the corners of McMullen Hall (corner closest to clock tower and corner coming from Berg Hall/Student Center) would catch traffic coming across campus and may be relatively inexpensive. The possibility will be explored further in future meetings.

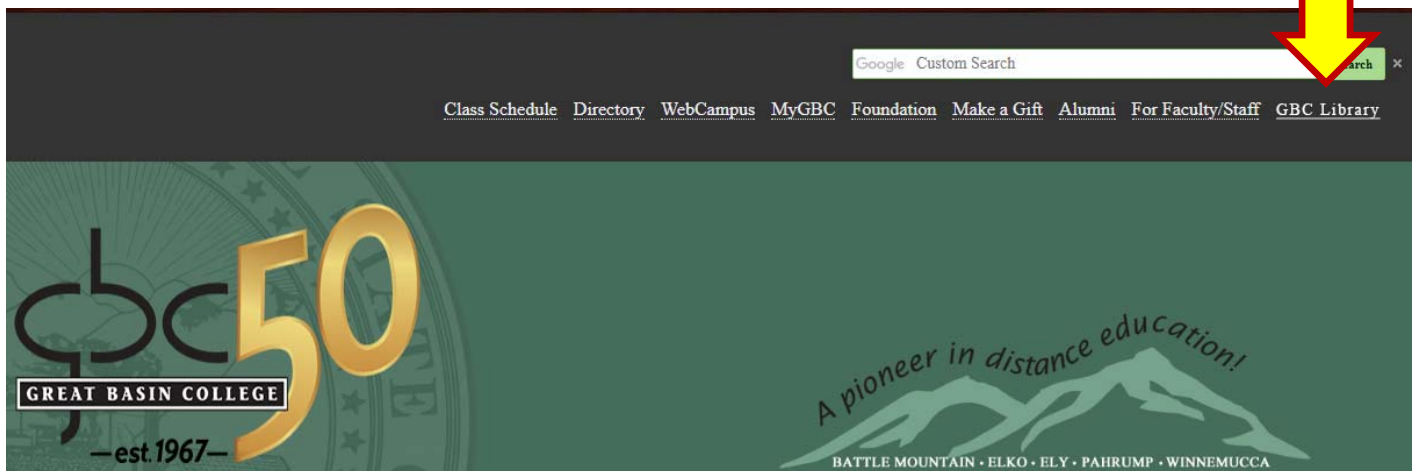
GBC LIBRARY COMMITTEE
ACTION ITEM – GBC Faculty Senate – 20 October 2017

PROPOSED RESOLUTION [Action required]

The Faculty Senate requests that a text link reading “GBC Library” be added to the top menu bar of the GBC main website page, since the GBC Library is both a public library and a resource shared across all programs on campus.

Justification:

- 1) The GBC Library is a public library widely used by the community, and not just GBC students. Members of the community should be able to quickly locate the link.
- 2) The GBC Library is not just “another program on campus,” but a shared resource which students should be encouraged to use regularly; ease-of-access helps with this goal.
- 3) In reviewing other institutions in Nevada, GBC peer institutions, and select others, the Library Committee feels that a prominent position on the main page load is the model for GBC to use [see attached sheet for details].
- 4) The proposed addition [see image below] will not distract from other elements of the current GBC main website page and presents no significant re-coding (it is just a text link).
