Overview

Completions Overview

Changes in reporting

- Revised "gender" to "sex" where applicable. Revised "men" to "male" and "women" to "female" where applicable.

- · Forgetting to enter in zero in at least one of the cells for CIP codes that do not have completions.
- Even though Teacher Preparation certificate programs may require a bachelor's degree for admission, they are considered subbaccalaureate undergraduate programs, and students in these programs are undergraduate students.
