The Financial Aid Office went through an audit by NSHE's internal auditors and a compliance audit by the Federal Department of Education during 2015-2016. We are using the reports from those audits to determine our results. The Dept. of Ed.'s audit only had a minor finding of a \$10 application fee being paid for with Pell grant Dollars. The Internal auditors found a few issues with our award letters not going out in a timely manner and the RT24 funds being returned late. (08/23/2016)
