Lincoln County High School students were offered a variety of online and IAV classes during the 2017/2018 academic year. Interactive Video Director, Bob Hannu went to Lincoln County and connected IAV to a classroom in the Adult Education classroom and students have been able to take IAV courses. The majority of high school students take the online classes but at least three ARL students have been able to utilize the IAV offerings.

In November of 2017, administration at Lincoln County High School was contacted by the Ely Center concerning the acquistion of a Career and College Readiness Grant by Dean Thomas Reagan that would pay for all tuition and textbooks for the spring 2018 semester. After meeting with Principal Soderborg and staff at Lincoln County, we increased enrollment to 15 students for the spring 2018 semester. (06/01/2018)

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
