Important Information: This agreement is based on any Associate of Arts or Associate of Science degree offered at WNC. Credit variations may occur based on the number of units required for each degree program.

Specific General Education Courses Required: ANTH 101 or SOC 101, HIST 105 or HIST 106 or HIST 208 or HIST 209. (HIST 208 or 209 are recommended), PSC 101 or PSC 210, PSY 101

These courses should be completed during the associate program. NOTE: Lower-division General Education requirements are fulfilled upon completion of the associate degree, with the exception of the courses listed above. If a General Education subject is not listed here, you may select any general education course approved for the associate degree program.
