New Business: INFORMATION ONLY:

1. Update on the NCC meeting with the Chancellor: *Louellen Monte*: Discussed parking fees at UNR and UNLV and how the amount they have to pay is high for classified council/staff. The Chancellor is going to request that the campus's have an open dialogue with their President's, as there's nothing that the NSHE Board of Regents can do. Discussed safety data on developing a public safety committee for the Chancellor and how it's going to be implemented into all of the institutions. This is because of the events that happened on December 6th at UNLV. They discussed fees that are going to be applied to institutions to classified staff that are taking classes at CSN. The Chancellor asked them to get more information on that and she will look into it. April 17th is the next meeting with the Chancellor if anyone wants Louellen to take things to the meeting. The student success fee is jumping up to \$25 next year that cannot be covered by Grant in Aid.
2. Update on the Board of Regents Meeting: *Louellen Monte*: Effective Fall of 2023 was the last semester that students could enroll in the Biological Sciences degree. The degree will be removed completely by Spring of 2025. Unanimously voted for our new Tenure professors that was sent out in an email by President Helen's. Also unanimously voted for the board of granting distinguished Nevadan Award. Approved the evaluation for President of UNLV. Allowed for the University police services to add more officers to the campus of UNLV.
3. Chili cookoff update: *Katelynn Gurr*: Friday April 12th for the chili cookoff here at the Elko campus. If all campus wants to host their own, they are more than welcome as long as they follow the rules. Along with chili there will be a soup cookoff as well. There will be a \$5 donation if people want, and they can taste test all the chili/soup to vote on whose is the best. The prizes will be wooden spoons that have designs burned into them. All the supplies will be donated by Classified Council so that we aren't spending more of the scholarship money and raising money for it instead. Decided that we should charge people \$1 to be able to sample all of the chili/soup and then \$5 recommended donation for a bowl. Melissa Leon suggested using tickets so that the people handling the chili/soup don't have to handle the money as well. We could have a separate table where someone handles receiving the money and handing out the tickets for people. Started a google docs for a sign-up sheet so that people can sign up to bring stuff for the cookoff.
4. Discussion of Classified Council May meeting: *Hilary Kinney*: Rescheduled the May meeting for the 24th so that we aren't interfering with the craziness of graduation. New Council members voting will be different this year. We want to give everyone plenty of time to vote for new members. Beginning of May send out nominations and then have the officers by the June meeting so that we can walk them through how everything goes.
