ADMISSION SELECTION CRITERIA Fall 2026

Eligible students will be numerically ranked according to total points received using the selection criteria below. Eligible students must have completed the certified nursing assistant course or have a current CNA license, completed ALL prerequisites, and have a TEAs composite score of 58.7% or higher. Total points will be determined after Spring 2026 grades have been posted at GBC. Please note that the applicant is responsible for ensuring that official grades for Spring 2026 semester for non- GBC coursework are submitted to the GBC Registrar. Admission will be offered to the applicants with the highest points based on program capacity. Meeting minimum application criteria does not guarantee admission to the program. In the event that applicants have an equal number of points, a tie breaker will be decided based on the grade of one or more of the following courses in the order they appear:

- a. BIOL 224
- b. BIOL 223
