

Curriculum Review Committee Report

October 2025

The following were recommended for approval:

New Program:

- Construction Technology Skills Certificate
 - The Construction Technology program equips students with foundational skills for careers in the construction industry, including introductory carpentry, blueprint reading, safe and proper use of tools, and basic framing techniques for floors, walls, ceiling joists, and roofs. The program will meet every Friday starting the second week of January and ending the Friday before Memorial Day. The program is 10 credits long, and completing students will receive a skills certificate.
 - CONS 101, Introduction to Construction Technology3 credits
 - CONS 120, Construction Plans and Specifications.....3 credits
 - CONS 108B, Construction Material and Methods4 credits
- Change Program:
 - Alternative Route to Licensure, Secondary Education
 - Course offerings are changing to better align with the Nevada Dept of Education's licensing requirements.
 - Secondary Education, biology and ELAD (Bachelor)
 - Due to the elimination of the Biology degree program upper division courses in biology are no longer being offered. These revisions will now include rigorous lower division offerings while still maintaining the 42 credits requirement for upper division within the education courses and mastery course (47 upper division credits)
