#### 10. ARCADE GAME RENTAL FOR GAME ROOM - ELKO

## **FOR POSSIBLE ACTION**

There will be a \$50/month rental fee to rent an arcade game for the Elko Center Game Room and a \$100 move in/move out fee. There will also be a set contract of one year which will be revisited at the end of the year to decide whether to renew the contract.

There are three options:

- A 4 player NBA jam
- A Neo-Geo (2 player machine with the ability to have 4 games)
- Pinball

Stephen Theriault asked if the arcade game will be running for the spring or fall semester. Student Advocate Garcia said that the game will probably be installed in the summer to be running in the fall.

President Dempsey asked if the \$100 covered the entire move in/move out process. Student Advocate Garcia said that she thinks that there is a separate \$100 fee for the move in and the move out.

Senator Stamp asked if officers could vote via email on which game to choose. Student Advocate Garcia typed the options into the Zoom chat box, and the officers partook in a vote to be counted and shared at the next meeting.

Senator Giere motioned to approve the request of \$50/month plus \$100 move-in/out fee for the arcade game rental. Senator Stamp seconded.

DISCUSSION: Motion passes unanimously.
